Instructions for Blessing the Home: Using the blessed chalk (available in the back of the Church or in the north vestibule) mark the lintel of your front door (or front porch step) as follows:

20 + C + M + B + 22

while saying: "The three Wise Men, Caspar, Melchior, and Balthazar followed the star of God's Son who became human two thousand and eighteen years ago. May Christ bless our home and remain with us throughout the new year. Amen."
