Dear Holy Rosary Friends and Families,

This weekend, we will celebrate two feasts important to our parish and to the Dominicans. First, our parish will celebrate the external solemnity of the 129th anniversary of the Dedication of Holy Rosary Church. Archbishop Thomas Cajetan Kelly formally re-dedicated the church on January 28, 1996. As our church was consecrated to our Lady of the Rosary, we implore her intercession for our parishioners, Dominican friars, and our friends and family. May we be gathered in the shelter of her mantle, especially those parishioners who have died. For 130 years, the parishioners and Dominican friars continue to preach the Gospel and devotion to our Lady of the Rosary in the city of Portland, Oregon. Our parish continues to be a destination parish for confessions, and Masses in the Ordinary and Extraordinary Forms with Gregorian chant and sacred polyphony.

Second, we celebrate the feast of Saint Thomas Aquinas, one of the great Dominican saints of the Order. To give a brief biography of this saint, St. Thomas was a son of a large aristocratic Italian family. Although very intelligent, he never bragged about it. His charism of knowledge was recognized as a gift from God. His parents had grand ambitions that one day he would become a Benedictine abbot. The castle of the Thomas family was located near Mount Casino, where the monks lived.

When he was six years old, Thomas was sent to the monastery to study. At the age of eighteen, Thomas went to Naples to complete his studies. There he met a group of Dominicans, and Saint Dominic, the founder of the Order, is still alive. He knew well that he wanted to be a priest, and felt called to join this group of Dominicans, who were famous for their preaching. When they heard about it, Thomas's parents were very angry. On his way to Paris to study, he was kidnapped by his brothers. They kept Thomas as a prisoner in one of their castles for more than a year. During that time, they used every means to get him to change his mind. One of his sisters also came to convince him to give up his calling. After fifteen months, Thomas was finally free to pursue his ideals.

Saint Thomas Aquinas had such a talent for writing about God that his writings continue to influence people over the world and down the centuries. His sermons on God and on the Faith stemmed from his passionate love of God. With all his heart, he simply wanted to dedicate his life to the service of Jesus and the Church. He was canonized by Pope Benedict XI in 1323, and soon recognized by the Church as one of the greatest Doctors of the Catholic Church. Let us ask Saint Thomas Aquinas to intercede for us, to help us grow in our understanding and knowledge of God.

Finally, as a quick update to the Provincial Chapter, the chapter is nearing completion. I ask for your continued

prayers for Fr. Paul, myself, as well as the work of all the capitulars, that we strive to follow the example of Our Holy Father Dominic in fulfilling the Order's preaching mission to the ends of the earth.
