In this month of January, we continue with the Christmas Season, and then return to Ordinary Time. The Christmas season, represented in white - the color of light, and symbol of joy and chastity - celebrates the mystery of the Incarnation. During these days, we continue to joyfully celebrate the mystery of the birth of the Lord in Bethlehem and in our hearts, especially the Solemnity of Mary as the Mother of God and the Feast of the Epiphany.
