Dear Holy Rosary Friends and Families,

We all have a special love for our church, Holy Rosary—a place of prayer, beautifully decorated with frescos and stained-glass windows—a building that lifts our hearts to God. So, we honor it in a special way this weekend by a solemn feast and a Mass on the anniversary of its dedication, January 28th.

But we also remember how it is at the service of Christ, an instrument of Christ. And the way it serves Him is hinted at in the Gospel for the Dedication of a Church.

It is the passage from St. Luke (19.1-10) when Our Lord informs a man He sees as He is passing through Jericho that He was coming to be a guest at his home—a man named Zacchaeus. Since this man had the occupation of a tax-collector, notorious for cooperating with the pagan Roman government as well as for overcharging and extortion, Our Lord's proposal got an immediate reaction from the crowd. So, Zacchaeus makes a point of generously committing, then and there, half of his possessions to the poor.

And in doing that shows the merciful heart Christ loves to see us, and which allows Him to enter, not just the physical home of Zacchaeus, but to enter into the more important dwelling of his soul. And this was really what Our Lord was after in offering to come to his home, that He might entice Zacchaeus to go further, and open the door to this inner dwelling.

Reminding us of Christ's words in Revelation: *Behold, I stand at the door and knock; if anyone hears my voice and opens the door, I come in to him and eat with him, and he with me* (Rev. 3:19).

Any physical building we call the house of God is really meant to foster this more important inner dwelling of God in the soul, which is the real temple God seeks to dwell in and is delighted by.

So, the great beauty of Holy Rosary is found above all in how well it fosters this inner dwelling of Christ in our souls. The tabernacle, containing Our Lord's true presence in the Holy Eucharist, situated at the focal point for the sanctuary. The altar of sacrifice symbolizing Christ's offering Himself to the Father. The mysteries of the Rosary depicted in the windows and on Martha Williams' beautiful fresco overhead.

All of this speaking of how great a gift this church is to our spiritual lives and our parish community. It leads us to God. It opens our minds to His truth, and our hearts to His goodness. Above all it speaks of His longing to dwell in our souls, as we more and more open the door to Him, through frequent prayer, the life of the sacraments, and especially
