Liturgy In Focus: The Reliquaries



Often seen tucked between the six tall altar candles are four of Holy Rosary's Reliquaries. A reliquary is an ornate or decorated container which holds relics of all sorts, most especially relics of the saints. In the case of the reliquary pictured above (partially disassembled to get a better picture!), we have some saints whose feast days occur this month of July and are worth a spot light. At the top is Saint Maria Goretti whose feast day is July 6; to the left are the Holy Martyrs of Gorkum whose feast day is July 9; and to the right is Saint Martin de Porres, OP, who feast day is November 3, but just so happens to share the same space in this reliquary. When we think of it in terms of eternity, I imagine the saints don't mind each other's company.


Saint Maria Goretti - July 6. Saint Maria Goretti was born in 1890. She was only 12 years old when she was martyred for safeguarding her purity from her attacker named Alessandro. He was sentenced to some 30 years in jail. After Maria appeared to him in a dream and forgave him, he repented. When Maria was canonized in 1950, Alessandro was present there in St. Peter's Square for the event. St. Maria Goretti is the patron saint of youth and of purity.

Holy Martyrs of Gorkum - July 9. The Martyrs of Gorkum were persecuted by Dutch Calvinists and were hanged to death at the end of the 16th century. Among them were Franciscans, Norbertines, and a Dominican named John of Cologne. Against the many accusations made against them, one of the martyrs responded with "Liar, thief, adulterer? Those was I always. But heretic was I never!" These 19 martyrs are venerated for their loyalty to the pope and their defense of the Real Presence in the Eucharist.
