Dear Holy Rosary Friends and Families,

We have entered into this month of June which is in a special way dedicated to Our Lord's love for us, revealed so wonderfully in His incarnation and offering Himself in sacrifice for our salvation. The love of Jesus that knows no bounds, not even holding back from the extreme torture of the cross. We are in the month of the Sacred Heart, recognized liturgically on the Solemnity of the Sacred Heart this coming Friday, June 16. Recognized as well in the revered image of Our Lord's heart, pierced by a lance and surrounded by a crown of thorns. His heart wounded by man's offenses, our spurning His infinitely generous love.

How ironic that this is also the month chosen by global culture to promote the LGBT agenda, with its rejection of both biblical morality and the divine wisdom present in the natural world itself, what we call the "natural law."

By that we mean our own humanity and way of living which arises from our Creator, whose wisdom is found in what He creates. In observing human nature, and how it works, we unite our minds with God's own wisdom imparted to creation. In legal terms: His eternal law is present within us, which we acknowledge as an eternal wisdom making us to be what we are—a natural law that unites us to Him. In short, we are creatures who share in the divine wisdom of the Creator.

Tragically, this presence of natural law within us has been under assault since at least the 1800's, to the point where society today is promoting new and ever more radical extremes of behavior. The legitimacy of homosexual relations is one extreme, as is also denying gender differences based in the human body. Of course, what is ultimately at stake is a denial of the Creator. A view of man's origin that is found not in God, but in purely material, evolutionary processes. Man is thus free to evolve as he sees fit, to be his own creator, and to reorder in any way he chooses the natural relationship of man and woman, or the bodily differences of male and female.

Amidst the normalization of the LGBT movement happening throughout society, it is important to be aware of its fundamental denial our origin in God. Obviously, Christians should never stop from reaching out to everyone today with understanding and compassion. But also, we reach out with the truth of our coming from Him who is the source of all goodness and beauty. Our origins are in Him. Within us is a law of nature that corresponds to His own eternal wisdom. Male and female we were created, God joining a man and a woman in marriage to bring forth children in a loving family.

Witnessing in this way, we unite our own lives with the love of His Sacred Heart: showing mercy for the sinner, bringing the light of truth to those embracing falsehood, enduring persecution for what is right, doing acts of reparation for offenses against His infinite love.
